SSN VALIDATION PROJECT STATISTICS

As a result of the recent Medi-Cal Social Security Number (SSN) Validation project (for March 1981 month of eligibility), the enclosed statistical report was compiled. The report indicates the total number of SSNs which failed to match SSA's records by county and the percentage this figure comprises of the county's total caseload. Totals are also listed by county for various aid category groupings and the percentage of the group this number comprises.

Upon completion of the next SSN Validation process, November or December 1981, similar statistics will be compiled and distributed to the counties for comparison with the original project. Results of the counties' validation efforts will be reflected in those statistics.
