STATE ONLY AFDC-U ADULTS AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE-UNEMPLOYED PARENTS (EA-UP) ADULTS

This letter is in reference to All County Letter No. 83-37 concerning coding of state only AFDC-U Adults and Emergency Assistance--Unemployed Parent (EA-UP) Adults.

The necessary program changes to the MEDS system will \underline{not} be installed by MEDS renewal for June 1983. This system change will not be installed until July 1983.

In the meantime, MEDS counties should report pregnant women 21 and over who are members of an EA-UP case as aid code 86 (pregnant women, no SOC). This system change delay has no impact on non-MEDS counties and they continue to have the option of reporting these cases as either 06 or 86.

Counties have the option to report pregnant women 21 and over who are members of a state only AFDC-U case to MEDS as either aid code 35 or 86 (pregnant women, no SOC), and that option has not been affected. CID system changes have been installed for June as indicated in ACL 83-37.
