MEDI-CAL ELIGIBILITY DATA SYSTEM (MEDS) RECONCILIATION

The purpose of this memo is to inform MEDS counties that the present monthly MEDS reconciliation process will be changed to a quarterly occurrence effective November 1983.

Currently, most MEDS counties submit reconciliation files on a monthly basis. The reconciliation cycle for fully operational MEDS counties will be changed to quarterly beginning October 1983. Fully operational on MEDS means counties that have been in MEDS operation for at least three months without experiencing any major system problems.

The MEDS reconciliation process is intended to be a periodic verification that daily updates, error resolution processes, EDP county document input procedures and data processing system reporting to MEDS are continuing to work correctly. It is not a substitute for working daily error reports.

The change to a specific schedule for reconciliation processing, plus the reduction in the number of reconciliations being processed will allow us to better control and ensure that reconcile files are received and processed appropriately.

As part of this change, reconciliations will be scheduled to be processed on the weekends in order to avoid any conflicts with the processing of daily updates. This schedule will also ensure that the entire reconciliation process is completed before the MEDS file must be made available for the next working day's online usage. For this reason it is imperative that counties submit their reconciliation files to the Department of Health Services within the time frame indicated on the attached schedule. The current MEDS change cycle process will be changed to hold a county's reconciliation tape until the weekend but still allow daily updates to be processed without causing conflicts and erroneous updates during the reconciliation process.

The Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch (MEB) will monitor the quarterly reconciliation process in order to identify any county that may require a more frequent schedule. Please note that in order to ensure proper ID card issuance and reduce the errors that are identified by reconciliation, it is imperative that each county review and correct the errors from the daily eligibility worker alert reports on a current basis. The attached schedule indicates reconciliation dates for all counties currently operational on MEDS and for most of the remaining counties. Counties not yet scheduled will be added as MED'S implementation planning is completed.

Counties identified by an asterisk on the attached list should plan to immediately adjust their reconciliation schedule to correspond to the dates indicated. The remaining EDP counties will be shifted from monthly to quarterly as they reach fully operational status.

If your county is to address major changes in your system which may impact MEDS, you should request a special test or a special reconciliation between the normally scheduled reconciliations. In order to accommodate this process, the request must be submitted at least two weeks in advance of the normally scheduled reconciliation. If our Data Systems Branch does not receive a county's reconciliation file for the date indicated on the attached schedule, they will not process that county's reconciliation file for that particular quarter.

If your county cannot schedule your reconciliation to ensure receipt by the attached indicated dates, or if your county is requesting a special test/ special reconciliation, please contact Connie Farmer of my staff at 445-1912.
